Complete refurbishment of 7 labs, conversion of a classroom into a further laboratory, additional classroom & 1 prep room

Value: £351k

**Duration of works:** 12 week phased programme

## Project Details:-

- > Free comprehensive design and consultation service
- > 2D and 3D CAD drawings provided, illustrating layouts
- > Full project management service
- > Removal of existing furniture and redundant services
- > Channel floor to accept new services where required
- > Blocked up existing doorway & windows where required
- > Supply of fume cupboard & provision for new extraction
- > Installation of new electrical and plumbing services
- > Installation of new radiators & removal of existing
- > Provide for interactive services
- > Supply and installation of furniture & all stools
- > Ceilings, decoration and flooring renewed
- > Fitting of gas proving system
- > Final connections, commissioning and certification of all works

The school were keen to take advantage of our discounted term time refurbishment service. A further advantage of operating in term time was that we had more resources available to accommodate the complex logistics of a phased programme in multiple locations around the school.

A rolling programme was agreed, concentrating on 2 labs at a time so that the school had full use of the remaining labs. The conversion of a classroom into a science lab required extensive reworking of the existing services and some re-modelling of the room. Despite the significant programme of works required for this term time refurbishment the school routine was not overly disrupted and the school were delighted with the end results.
